Dear Quilting Friends,

The Water Mill Museum's 35th Annual Quilt Show and Sale will be held from <u>Thursday</u>, <u>August 19th through</u> <u>Sunday</u>, <u>September 5th</u>. Quilts in good condition, of any design, size or age are welcome at the Museum show. If you would like to submit more than one quilt, please complete a registration form for <u>EACH</u> quilt. Please fill in all information, including a good description, and send the registration forms by August 12th to: Eileen Noonan, WMM Quilt Show, 11 Mill Pond Ln, Water Mill, NY 11976.

Quilt drop off is Tuesday, August 17th **during the Museum business hours of 11-4.** If you have a number of quilts to check in, please allow yourself enough time to have us register your quilts and give you your receipts.

Quilts should remain at the Museum for the duration of the show (unless they are sold), and must be picked up on Tuesday, September 7th. Quilts cannot remain at the Museum after September 8th. If either time frame does not work for you, we can make alternate arrangements if requested in advance.

The museum staff will do their best to prominently display quilts from everyone entering our show. The Museum's commission will still be 25% of sales. If you intend to sell your quilt(s), remember to include the commission in your asking price. For example, if the quilt is sold for \$500.00, the seller will receive \$375.00. The museum will collect and report the sales tax. In order to process commission payments, we must have a completed W-9 form from each seller. Sales totaling \$600.00 or more require us to generate a 1099. Blank W-9 forms will be available at the museum or at www.irs.gov.
